LAKE LIFE AT KBY

Camp Kum-Ba-Ya is set in 45 wooded acres on beautiful Kentucky Lake in Marshall County, about 12 miles northeast of Benton. Our camp will accommodate up to 75 persons for lodging, dining, and gatherings.

THE BILLY WILLIAMS LODGE

Our lodge offers a commercial kitchen, a large dining or meeting room to accomodate 75 persons and two break-out meeting rooms for events in any season. With two showers in each restroom, the breakout rooms can serve as dorm rooms for 12 overnight guests. Our WIFI, projector and television make this a nice space for training events, movie nights, or video conferencing.

NEW CABINS

In 2023, Camp Kum-Ba-Ya is transitioning from ten rustic A-frame cabins to eight insulated all-season cabins with finished interiors. Two cabins will offer ensuite restrooms. TWO-PERSON CABINS

Our three rustic, two-person cabins near the lodge allow for a short walk to the heart of the campground. Window units keep these cabins cool during the hot months.
