

TREASURER'S REPORT

Financial Information for the month ended September 30, 2023:

West Area:

The total receipts for the month ended September 30, 2023, were \$10,181 with total expenses of \$11,616 giving us a negative cash flow of \$1,435. We ended the month with an operational cash balance of \$93,667. We have a restricted cash balance of \$9,773 which consists mainly of \$4,355 in tornado relief contributions and \$4,540 in youth activities restricted monies.

Camp Kum-Ba-Ya:

The total operational receipts for the month ended September 30, 2023, were \$819 with total expenses of \$1,865 giving us a negative cash flow of \$1,045. We ended the month with an operational cash balance of \$59,436. This balance will give us a positive start to next camp season. We also had a restricted cash balance of \$99,584 which will be used mainly on camp upgrades. The large amount was due to a very successful fundraising drive.
