

### TREASURER'S REPORT

Financial Information for the month ended October 31, 2023:

#### West Area:

The total receipts for the month ended October 31, 2023, were \$4,991 with total expenses of \$6,460 giving us a negative cash flow of \$1,469. We ended the month with an operational cash balance of \$92,199. We have a restricted cash balance of \$9,949 which consists mainly of \$4,355 in tornado relief contributions and \$4,540 in youth activities restricted monies.

#### Camp Kum-Ba-Ya:

The total operational receipts for the month ended October 31, 2023, were \$4,772 with total expenses of \$2,939 giving us a positive cash flow of \$1,833. We ended the month with an operational cash balance of \$62,020. This balance will give us a positive start to next camp season. We also had a restricted cash balance of \$98,897 which will be used mainly on camp upgrades. The large amount was due to a very successful fundraising drive.
