## WEEK OF COMPASSION SITE LEADER TRAINING

Week of Compassion is planning a joint Leadership Training with our partners at Brethren Disaster Ministries in January 2024. The training is for people who have a heart for service, enjoy working on-site with volunteer groups, and walk alongside communities recovering from disasters in the United States.

Typically, Site Leaders serve on-site for three to 12 weeks of their choosing (or for single weeks, if local). Completing the training adds people to our list of available leaders; it does not obligate leaders to serve. Site Leaders will have opportunities to determine participation based on availability and interest for future service.

During the training, leaders will learn to support disaster recovery and become certified to lead on-site projects with Week of Compassion in one of two ways:

- 1. Volunteer Experience Leader providing hospitality for volunteer teams, serving and guiding educational/faith formation components (daily reflections, conversations with local partners, etc.)
- 2. Recovery Project Leader leading volunteer teams in repair/rebuild projects and liaising with construction partners and community leaders

Week of Compassion is striving to increase the accessibility of our training. Transportation to and from the hands-on training site will be covered, along with food and lodging for the week. Site Leaders receive a weekly stipend, while having opportunities to serve God and neighbor, build their skills, and learn about innovative solutions to support community resilience. Let Week of Compassion know if other accommodations would be helpful for your participation.

Both sessions are required to be credentialed as part of the Week of Compassion Core Crew. If needed, Week of Compassion can arrange alternate in-person training dates. Register by January 12.

## TREASURER'S REPORT

Financial information for the month ended November 30, 2023:

#### West Area:

The total receipts for the month ended November 30, 2023 were \$17,498 with total expenses of \$9,361 giving us a positive cash flow of \$8,137. We ended the month with an operational cash balance of \$100,789. We have a restricted cash balance of \$9,949 which consists mainly of \$4,355 in tornado relief contributions and \$4,540 in youth activities restricted monies.

## Camp Kum-Ba-Ya:

The total operational receipts for the month ended November 30, 2023 were \$1,304 with total expenses of \$18,267 giving us a negative cash flow of \$16,964. The large increase in expenditures was due to the Region billing us \$12,465 for insurance. We ended the month with an operational cash balance of \$45,056. This balance will give us a positive start to next camp season. We also had a restricted cash balance of \$98,867 which will be used mainly on camp upgrades. The large amount was due to a very successful fundraising drive.
