#### **CAMP AGAPE FOR GRADES 6-8 IN FOSTER CARE!**

Camp Kum-Ba-Ya and Benton First Christian Church are again partnering to host Camp Agape-a week of sleep away camp for up to 25 middle-school youth (having completed grades 6, 7, or 8) who currently live in foster care.

Camp Agape, scheduled for July 1-5, combines Camp Kum-Ba-Ya's spiritual mission of sharing God's love, community, and belonging, with the emotional support, mentoring, and instruction in practical, everyday skills that youth in foster care will need in life. From the moment campers arrive, we aim for each one to feel the sense of belonging that comes from having a special place set aside just for them to sleep and be. When they leave at the end of the week, our aim is for each one to feel loved and valued as children of God, with skills to live and grow in relationships and in community.

## "GENERATIONAL TRAUMA: GETTING REAL ABOUT HOW WE HEAL" WITH DR. IRIE LYNNE SESSION





### END OF 2023 FINANCIALS

Financial Information for the Month Ended December 31, 2023:

#### West Area:

The total receipts for the month ended December 31, 2023, were \$13,073 with total expenses of \$13,098 giving us a negative cash flow of \$25. We ended the month with an operational cash balance of \$100,763. We have a restricted cash balance of \$10,100 which consists mainly of \$4,355 in tornado relief contributions and \$4,540 in youth activities restricted monies.

#### Camp Kum-Ba-Ya:

The total operational receipts for the month ended December 31, 2023, were \$3,200 with total expenses of \$11,984 giving us a negative cash flow of \$8,784. We ended the month with an operational cash balance of \$36,272. This balance will give us a positive start to next camp season. We also had a restricted cash balance of \$99,398, which will be used mainly on Camp upgrades. The large amount was due to a very successful fundraising drive earlier in the year.
